### **Privacy Statement**

QVI, Inc., dba The Galley ("The Galley") respects your privacy and is committed to protecting it through our compliance with this policy. This Statement of Privacy applies to The Galley Website and governs data collection and usage. By using The Galley website, you consent to the data practices described in this statement

Please read this policy carefully to understand our policies and practices regarding your information and how we will treat it. You are under no obligation to agree to this Privacy Policy, but by using the Site, or by clicking to accept or agree to the Privacy Policy when this option is made available to you, you accept and agree to be bound and abide by this Privacy Policy. If you do not agree to this Privacy Policy, do not access or use the Site.

This policy may change from time to time, as described below. Your continued use of the Site after we make changes is deemed to be acceptance of those changes, so please check the policy frequently for updates.

### **Use of the Services by Persons Under 21 Not Permitted**

The Galley intends only persons who are 21 years or older to use the Services. Any use of the Services by persons under the age of 21 is strictly prohibited. You agree that by using this website you represent that you are at least 21 years old and that you are legally able to enter into this Agreement. Use of the website by persons under 21 is strictly prohibited.

Our Services, including our website, are intended for a mature audience. We do not direct any of our content at children. Do not supply to us or disclose on the Services any personal information of any person under 21 years of age, as we do not intend to collect information from anyone under 21 or invite them to view or participate in this website or sign up for communications from us.

### **Collection of Your Personal Information**

Users who register for mailing lists on our website will receive the option to receive newsletters, promotions, and other special benefits. We may collect names, email addresses, telephone numbers, and mailing addresses or telephone numbers from such users. The Galley also collects anonymous demographic information, which is not unique to you, such as your ZIP code, age, gender, preferences, interests and favorites.

There is also information about your computer hardware and software that is automatically collected by The Galley. This information can include: your IP address, browser type, domain names, access times and referring Website addresses. This information is used by The Galley for the operation of the website

### **Website Cookies**

The Galley's website uses cookies (small text files stored on your computer) to help remember your settings, preferences, and selections as you surf through our website with your web browser. We may use web cookies in order to maintain your web browser's website session, track your use of our website, and to store your preferences and selections. Third-party cookies from Google and other companies are also used to display promotions and advertisements relevant to you, track your website usage, and to generate website usage analytics.

For your privacy, They Galley's and third-party cookies are designed to not store personally identifiable data. We do not store personal information in cookies, nor transmit personal information to third parties via cookies.

If you prefer not to receive cookies, you may configure your browser not to accept them at all, or to notify and require approval before accepting new cookies. Some web pages/sites may not function properly if the cookies are turned off, or you may have to provide the same information each time you visit those pages.

We may use the following types of cookies:

- **Strictly necessary cookies:** These cookies are essential in order to enable you to move around the Site and use its features, such as accessing secure areas of the website.
- **Performance cookies:** These cookies collect information about how you and other Users use the website, for instance which pages you go to most often, and if you get error messages from web pages. These cookies don't collect information that identifies a user. All information these cookies collect is aggregated and so anonymous. It is only used to improve how our website works.
- **Functionality cookies:** These cookies allow us to remember choices you make (such as your username, language or the region you are in) and provide enhanced, more personal features. These cookies can also be used to remember changes you have made to parts of web pages that you can customize. They may also be used to provide Services you have asked for such as commenting on a blog. The information these cookies collect may be anonymized and they cannot track your browsing activity on other websites.

### **Information Collected Automatically or Passively**

We may use automatic data collection technologies in order to collect certain information about your equipment, browsing activities, and patterns, including details of your visits to our website, including location data, traffic data, logs, and other communication data; and information about your computer and Internet connection, including your IP address, browser and operating system.

We may also use third party proprietary analytics metrics technologies such as Google Analytics to collect non-personal information when you use our website on your personal computer or mobile device. These tools and technologies use server log files, Cookies, and other tracking technologies to collect and analyze broad demographic information about the visitors to our website.

The information collected automatically may include personal information or we may maintain it or associate it with personal information we collect in other ways or receive from third parties, allowing us to improve your experience and recognize you when you return to our Site.

### **Use of Your Personal Information**

The Galley may collect and use your personal information to operate The Galley website and deliver the services you have requested. The Galley also may contact you by email, regular mail, text message, or telephone from time to time with information about our new products and services, special offers, upcoming events, and changes to this Website, or surveys to conduct research about your opinion of current services or of potential new services that may be offered.

The Galley does not sell, rent or lease its customer lists to third parties. The Galley may, from time to time, contact you on behalf of external business partners about a particular offering that may be of interest to you. The Galley will disclose your personal information, without notice, only if required to do so by law or in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to: (a) conform to the edicts of the law or comply with legal process served on The Galley or the site; (b) protect and defend the rights or property of The Galley; and, (c) act under exigent circumstances to protect the personal safety of users of The Galley, or the public.

## **Where We Store Your Personal Data**

All information you provide to us is stored on our secure servers located in the United States. Where we have given you (or where you have chosen) a password which enables you to access the Site, you are responsible for keeping this password confidential. You must not share a password with anyone. Any payment transactions will be encrypted using Secure Socket Layer (SSL) technology.

Unfortunately, the transmission of information via the internet is not completely secure. Although we will do our best to protect your personal data, we cannot guarantee the security of your data transmitted to our Site; any transmission is at your own risk. Once we have received your information, we will use strict procedures and security features to try to prevent unauthorized access.
